

Making a Leaf Bowl

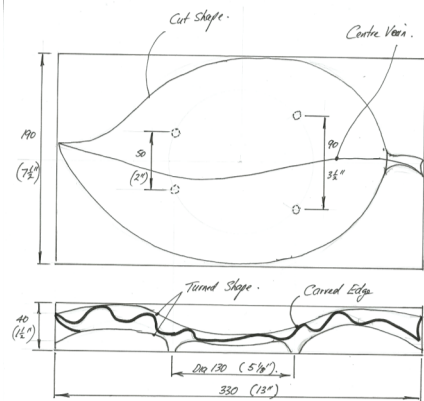


Do some research and look around the bush to get some different shapes.



Make a prototype to see if your design looks ok.

It does not need to be well finished, but should be in proportion.



Turn the foot ring and check heights with a profile gauge.

Turn the chuck spigot.

Select your timber then make a drawing to suit the size of the timber you have.

Spread the chuck jaws out to hold the top while turning the bottom



Use any of the above tools to carve the profile.



Draw the shape of the leaf ready for carving. Hold in a carving Jig.

Turn the inside shape



Shaping the edges with a Proxxon Disc.



Turning off the chuck spigot, Hand carve the small centre cylinder
